

FAQ-083-Vehicles-How do I search multiple vehicles using VINs?



Easily find multiple vehicles in stock by searching by VIN.

To make it easier to search for several vehicles in a single operation, we have added a new filter called "**VIN**" to the table of the "**Vehicles**" module.

You can use it to enter multiple VIN numbers one after the other.

-If you choose to enter the numbers manually, press the **'Enter key'** to separate them.

-If you choose to **'copy/paste'** the VIN numbers you require from a source outside of OpenFlex, the numbers will be automatically separated.
