Access to the platform by dual authentication

- For security reasons, a dual authentication connection system has been integrated into the platform.
- Each user will have to authenticate themselves by entering the code they receive at the e-mail address indicated in their OpenFlex profile.
- The security code sent by e-mail will be valid for 15 minutes.



☰ Managers with access rights to account management will have to perform dual authentication each time they log on to the platform.

☰ Users who do not have this right will be able to postpone the requirement for dual authentication for 30 days by ticking the appropriate box when they first log on to the platform.



Only an administrator user can access the platform settings.


Account management gives access to the creation, modification and deletion of other users' accounts.

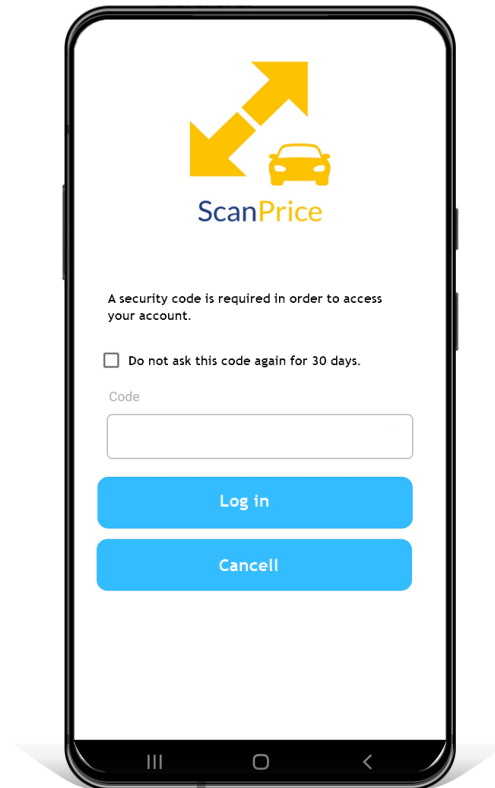
